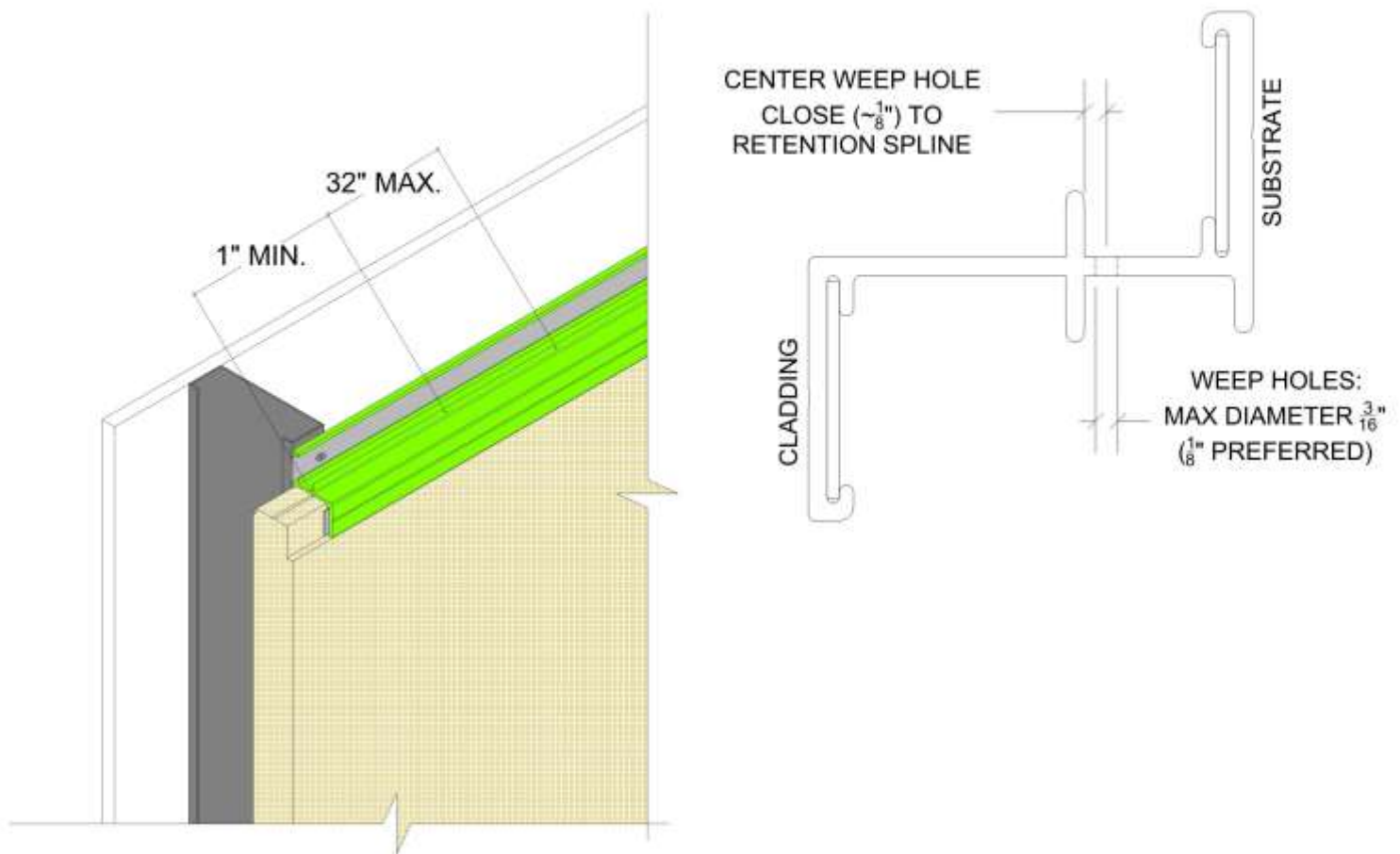


Drilling GreenGirt™ Weeps

Drilling GreenGirt is an easy, routine operation. Use any standard high-speed steel drill bit, which will require frequent sharpening. Properly sharpened brad-point bits provide excellent results. Utilize the following best practices when drilling GreenGirt:

- The drill speed should be equivalent to those used for drilling hardwood
- Carbide-tipped drills are recommended when drilling large quantities
- A wood backup plate can help to reduce breakout on the back side of the hole



ENSURE WEEP HOLES ARE A MINIMUM OF 1" FROM THE EDGE OF ANY GREENGIRT, AND THAT SPACING IS NO GREATER THAN 32" O.C.
